## ROUTE DESCRIPTION

This short, gentle ride is an ideal introduction to the sights of Taynuilt and the surrounding area.

Starting at the station, follow the quiet road to the shore of Loch Etive and the old pier. Enjoy fine views of the surrounding hills, before visiting the historic Bonawe Ironworks to discover a wealth of information about life in and around Taynuilt during the 18th century.

An optional return route is available via rough farm track with gate (Ⓡ) for a circular link, or retrace your steps along the road.
